

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

Updated Jan 12, 2024

Happy New Year to families and staff! The number of Covid hospital admissions in our area have increased. The northeastern part of our state has been upgraded to yellow/medium. Everyone should continue to monitor for symptoms of Covid, Flu, RSV as well as other illnesses. We have also seen some "viral illness". Please monitor your child for illness and test for Covid if they are experiencing symptoms. We have seen and heard of persons who test negative for up to 3 days and then test positive on day 4. If your child tests negative and has symptoms, we prefer them to stay home. With any type of illness, if your child is not able to participate in all school activities, they should be staying home. If they are coughing/sneezing, runny nose-especially with yellow or green mucous, have a fever, vomiting or diarrhea, poor appetite or sore throat, they should stay home. We consider a temperature of 100.4 or higher to be a fever, and they should stay home. Anyone who has had a fever, they should be fever free for 24 hours without using Tylenol or Advil.

We have a limited number of Covid tests available here at school, and you can order 4 tests per household through the United States Postal Service if you didn't order in late November. The website for ordering is https://special.usps.com/testkits.
