Attention All Families and Staff



NEWS FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE!

- Our region of the state remains at moderate activity level.
- We continue to follow ECLC of NJ policy as well as the recommendation of our local health department for unvaccinated close contacts to quarantine for 14 days from last contact.
- If an unvaccinated staff or student's household member is sick and waiting to get COVID tested or for results, the staff or student should stay home until results are negative.
- For anyone who travels: If you are unvaccinated, please contact the health office for quarantine and testing requirements. If you are fully vaccinated and travel domestically, you do not have to quarantine, but should monitor for symptoms and stay home if any develop. If you are fully vaccinated and travel internationally, you should monitor for symptoms, get tested between days 3 and 5, but do not have to quarantine if you are symptom free and a COVID test is negative.

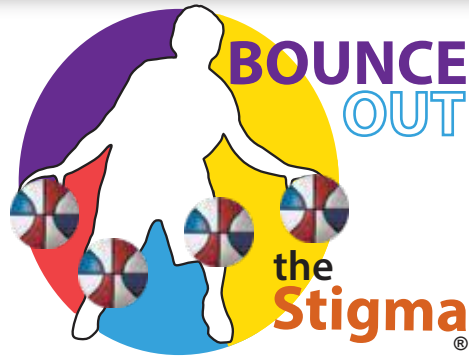
