Students in room 104 get some fresh air on a beautiful autumn day and help to keep our flower garden nice and fresh!














Room 102 took an exciting CBI trip to the Waldwick Police Station where they learned plenty about how law enforcement works!



Important Notice from the Health Office

COVID-19 UPDATE

Unfortunately, we are seeing an increase in the number of Covid hospitalizations in our area, and there have been some cases here at school. We no longer do contact tracing. When there is a positive case in a classroom, we notify all parents and staff in that room.

If your child has Covid symptoms, please test them. If positive, keep them home and contact the health office. You can contact their doctor and they can be tested for flu and RSV. **A NEGATIVE COVID TEST DOES NOT MEAN YOUR CHILD IS WELL ENOUGH TO COME TO SCHOOL**. If your child is a close contact to someone who has tested positive for Covid, please contact the health office for testing and masking recommendations.

At this time, we do not have a masking policy at ECLC. That may change if cases increase or we see there's an outbreak. If you would like your child to wear a mask at school, you can certainly send them in with a mask.

Free Covid tests are available through the United States Postal Service once again starting Sept 25, 2023. You can get 4 per household. Also, expiration dates on Covid tests have been extended. Please check the website included in the free test link to check if tests you have at home are still valid.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DE COVID-19

Desafortunadamente, estamos viendo un aumento en la cantidad de hospitalizaciones por Covid en nuestra área y ha habido algunos casos aquí en la escuela. Ya no hacemos rastreo de contactos. Cuando hay un caso positivo en un salón de clases, notificamos a todos los padres y al personal en ese salón.

Si su hijo tiene síntomas de Covid, pruébelo. Si es positivo, manténgalos en casa y comuníquese con la oficina de salud. Puede comunicarse con su médico y le podrán hacer pruebas de gripe y VRS. UNA PRUEBA DE COVID NEGATIVA NO SIGNIFICA QUE SU HIJO ESTÁ LO SUFICIENTEMENTE BIEN PARA VENIR A LA ESCUELA. Si su hijo es un contacto cercano con alguien que dio positivo por Covid, comuníquese con la oficina de salud para obtener recomendaciones sobre pruebas y enmascaramiento.

En este momento, no tenemos una política de uso de mascarillas en ECLC. Eso puede cambiar si los casos aumentan o vemos que hay un brote. Si desea que su hijo use una máscara en la escuela, ciertamente puede enviarlo con una máscara.

Las pruebas de Covid gratuitas estarán disponibles a través del Servicio Postal de los Estados Unidos una vez más a partir del 25 de septiembre de 2023. Puede obtener 4 por hogar. También, se han ampliado las fechas de caducidad de las pruebas de Covid. Consulte el sitio web incluido en el enlace de la prueba gratuita para comprobar si las pruebas que tiene en casa siguen siendo válidas.
