




Room 102 has been enjoying some early spring weather by taking walks and watching the trees start to bud!








Students in 204 are learning about the history of Ireland and getting in the St. Patricks' Day spirit!



# STRIDER BIKE



#### **Strider Bike**

#### WHAT IS IT?

Strider Bikes are balance bikes with no pedals. This allows children to propel the bike with their feet while working on their balance, which is the hardest task of riding a bike. Overtime as the child gains balance, pedals can be added on and the child can be taught how to push the pedals to propel themselves.

#### **BIKING BENEFITS:**

- Biking helps with:
  - balance
  - coordination
  - endurance
  - strength
  - habits and routines
  - self-esteem

Biking can be a great way for families to enjoy activities together and give children a sense of independence!

#### Saftey

- Always ensure your child is wearing a helmet
- Knee and elbow pads can help avoid scrapes that may occur during the learning period
- Always supervise the child on the bike when outdoors.

#### Aging and sizing

 Strider bikes can be used as early as 6 months old! They come in. rocking, toddler, child and adult sizing so individuals of all ages can learn to ride a bike!
